The Salvation of Nations Ministry – TSNM, India is a humanitarian charitable trust and a non-government organization (NGOs) our head office is located in Delhi. We are professionally managed by its core-board members/ Director's, dedicated staffs & volunteers.

Since year 2013, we are focusing on Education, Health and alleviating poverty & social injustice, discrimination. Since last nine years it has been successfully functioning towards enriching the lives of poorest of poor, needy, downtrodden and marginalized or deprived section of the society in Delhi as well as other part of the country.

We do these well planned and comprehensive programs in Education, Health & Hygiene, Vocational training programs, and Community mobilization & awareness programs, Legal & human rights advocacy, Self-Help training programs and Relief & rehabilitation programs etc. Overall our goal is to "Ensure Joy on Every face" though these social development and Individual empowerment activities for poorest of Poor, deprived, needy people (Men/Women's & Children's) from the marginalized communities, leading to improvement in their lives and livelihoods and help them to live the life of integrity and dignity.

In the financial year 2022-23, we (TSNM-India) could directly reaches around 25000 thousand people (Men, Women and children's') through relief, awareness and communities mobilization and various other programs across the Delhi & Uttar Pradesh. We could reach around 10000 children's through "Sanskar Siksha Kendra" under this educational unite we are providing free-education for all. Around 3000 hundred women get trained and certified through "Utthan Cutting & tailoring center" this is one of our vocation training program unite. "The Salvation of Nations Ministry directly reaches 6000 thousand house wife and adolescence girl through Adult Literacy, Self-defense & Community outreach & Awareness programs against Domestic violence & human trafficking. In FY-22-23 TSNM, India could conduct couple of health camps & awareness programs, throughout these programs we could reach around 4000 women's from the slums of Delhi & NCR.

On the entire line, **"The Salvation of Nations Ministry" (TSNM)** exists to serve the poorest of poor, marginalized, needy, neglected and deprived sections of the Indian societies – irrespective of their ethnic, social, sexual, or religious & cast background. Our service are being provided for all sustainable, social, and spiritual development of the poor, needy, and marginalized people of this country keeping in mind the promotion of Justice, brotherhood, communal harmony & peace and national integration. It has a highly motivated team of professional staff and volunteers etc.

From the Desk of Director

It gives me immense pleasure to present you our 10th annual report of "The Salvation of Nations Ministry" for financial year 2022-23. In past year, most of our work focused on education, awareness, health & hygiene and relief work in Delhi & Uttar Pradesh. Our programs continued to reach out Men/Women's/ adolescence boys & girls, especially from the marginalized and poorest of poor communities in the remotest region, to make positive social impact in their lives and livelihoods. We work in one of the huge slums of Delhi to directly reach out to 30000 thousand people though health, education, vocational training, and awareness programs. Among of whom 10000 thousands were women's and girls'. Which describing the progress made in the various fields of holistic development of social work like: *Free-Education, Adult Literacy, Vocational training, Youth development programs, Women & Children's developments, Health & hygiene, Awareness & advocacy programs, Social, Cultural programs and Disaster & Relief work etc.*

Lasting change can only become a reality when underlying causes of poverty and social exclusion are addressed in holistic manner. TSNM-India worked in the past year around the poor and downtrodden who all are beneficiaries on the ground, it is an attempt to bring about more meaningful and long-term change. Community-based collective action which encourage marginalized people to hold the authorities responsible and accountable to deliver services, are reaping a rich dividend. Our programs have touch the lives of thousands of poor, needy & marginalized people specially women's and children, bringing about a change which is remarkable. India's growth has also been accompanied with a fair share of challenges lopsided power relations driven by caste and class boundaries, patriarchy, and disparate economic opportunities, have added fuel to the fire of poverty and social injustice. Our Areas of Involvements

Since 2014, TSNM, India has made its existence among the local slums & urban marginalized and poorest of poor community and its people. We are serving people in several areas of North-East & West Delhi such like J.J. Camp Surajpark, Rajavihar, Sahabd Dayri Bhagwanpura, Jahangirpuri, Sanjay colony, Badli & Samaypur, Nilothi, Chander vihar and Nangloi.

In these areas we are running several programs like; Free-education center, Adult literacy programs, Cutting & tailoring center, Vocational English speaking classes, Training programs for drop-outs student, Awareness programs, Health Camps and family counseling center.

Hereby, we are sharing our work what we have done or which is being done in our operational areas and its surrounding areas of North-East & West Delhi during the last passing year 2022–23.

Poverty eradication Programs

Since last 9 years, TSNM, India are continually making its efforts towards poverty reduction programs. To address this issue several initiatives have been taken, like we have local teams of volunteers & staffs. We chose people and help them with microfinance (we provide them small loan) to start their small shops or vender ship. We collect used casual & summer clothes, winter clothes, and shoes or sleepers from high class peoples & societies and distribute to the poorest of poor and marginalized people of the slums & rode side families.



In year 2022- 23, around 400 kg clothes, 125 pair shoes and sleepers had etc. been distributed to such people. Through-out the year we specially collected clothes for men/women's, around 600 (One thousand and eight needy men hundred) and women's of the slums get benefited through the poverty reduction programs.



Children's Development programs

4 Child Right issues and children's at risk: -



We all know that, the children's are the gifts from God, and we also understand that they are the feature of our society and hope for our country (India).

TSNM, India are passionate and actively involved in equipping and nurturing our children's who all are poorest of poor, needy and deprived; we help them to reaching to the schools. Our staff & volunteers are committed and focused to help them to get proper education, health & hygiene, and the life with dignity. In year 2022-23, around 900 children's got admissions in the schools through us. Everv child individually was taken to schools for admission.

These initiatives made by us to assist & help hundreds of poor children to get proper schooling and get educated.

Free - Education :- TSNM, India are copiously focused and steadfast to provide free



through this unite we have been reaching and educating thousands of such poor and needy children's throughout the years. Under this unite our team reaching to the children's of the slums and motivate their parents to send their kids to our SSK center and the schools;



also encourage our children's for in-door or out-door games and quiz & drawing competitions etc.



education to the all poor, needy and downtrodden children's who are not attending the school or their parents cannot afford for basic educational expenses of the coaching or tuition fee of their kids. We have found that still their parents are not focusing on education especially for girl child. "Sanskar Siksha Kendra – (SSK)" is the educational unite of "The Salvation of Nations Ministry;



we encourage them to enroll their names also in our center. Here we provide them free coaching classes and all related study materials (books, notebooks, uniforms and shoes) etc. During the passing year 2022–23, around 600 (Six Hundred) children's get benefited through **"Sanskar Siksha Kendra"**. We out-door games and guiz & drawing

<u>Summer</u> Children's

<u>Camp</u>: - The Salvation of Nations Ministry, is focused and committed to equip these children's with full of potentials and skills.

It's unfortunate for our societies that they are living their lives in need and poverty. They have insufficient opportunity and resources to get complete holistic development.

Our people or staff are reaching to such children's and bringing them in such camps which use to be conducted during the schools holidays, especially during the summers vacations.



These camps are called **"Baal Grishma Mahotsav"** this year we had privilege to held children's camps for 4 days of a week; age group of 5–18 years all local children's could participated in this camp.

Around 1000 one thousand children's could take part in camp during 4 days programs. During these camps we could educate them about "Patriotism" our value & culture, "Health & Hygiene," "Cleanliness" etc. we teach them these subject through the songs, dance, games, paly & stories. After the camp we follow these children's to encourage them and help them for their studies. We have noticed that through such children's programs are overcoming from their bad habits and addictions, and they are engaging themselves for noble cause our societies.

Children's Clubs: -

"The Salvation of Nations Ministry" educates non-formal education to the local slums children's through the children's clubs.

We have 6 children's clubs in several areas which is been taken care by Sunday school clubs leaders. We have children's clubs in Suraj Park, Azadpur, Jahangir Puri, and Rajavihar colonies.



These clubs are identified by their names like (Nav jeevan, Nayee Sristi, and Nav Jyoti children's club). These all clubs are located in the slums like Samaipur, Badli. Surajpark, Jahangirpuri, areas etc. Who are called to participate on every Sunday in their specific clubs? During Sunday clubs children's comes to the clubs the play,



discuss, learn, and dance, through these activities club leader use to teach these children's about health, cleanliness, current affairs, general knowledge, and about the social culture. TSNM-India is intend to equip all such children's with complete knowledge and lead them to holistic developments.

Clothes & Uniform Distribution: - TSNM-India existing to serve all the poorest



of poor, needy, deprived, marginalized and downtrodden children's who all are living their life on the street and in the slums of Delhi. Often when I see such children's my heart feel grieved, and willing some moreover to do for them. Because such children's don't have good and clean clothes, they don't have footwear or shoes. "The Salvation of

Nations Ministry" making effort to reach such and very needed children's of surrounding areas, and provide them old clothes which has been washed and clean by our volunteer, also some footwear, and shoes. If they are school going kids, we also provide them their schools uniform, so that they can go to the school in uniform. In 2022-23, Around 300 kg old clothes which collected from high society people



were distributed to such children's and also for adult and distributed uniform and shoes for 50 children's who attends schools. 250 pair sports shoes were distributed in Sanjay colonies, Suraj Park, Rajavihar Colonies, and Bhagwanpura slums.

* Self Defense Program: -



TSNM, India having concerned for women and girl child security or protection against sexual harassment or girl child trafficking. We have made initiative for young girls and women's of the slums with the association of "Parivartan Cell" of Delhi Police. During the year 2022-23 we conducted couple of selfdefense training program, these programs use to be one week programs with help of "Parivartan Cell" of Delhi Police; during the training programs police officials & staff came to train them. Around 120 young girls were trained once in a 5 days of a week for "Self Defense Camp". End of the camp all participants were certified and certificate was conferred to the all participants.

Awareness & Advocacy program

Health & Hygiene Camp



"TSNM-India" is focused to create awareness in the slums and unauthorized colonies; mainly when you get enter in the slum you may found filthy garbage and dust everywhere. Slum people are not having much concern about the cleanliness & hygiene. Due to polluted environment local dwellers are falling sick with dengue, malaria, and other viral etc. Children are also getting sick & weaker. We use to conduct advocacy programs in these slums; we gather local people from community, and our expert teach and guide them, that how to stay clean and hygiene.

Advocacy and awareness programs help people to get informed & aware about theses health & social issues. We have found such programs are making remarkable changes among slums. We have given a saying "Swachh Raho, Swasth Bano" ("Be Clean and stay healthy").

Community mobilization

India has complete TSNM – focused on community outreach & programs. awareness Our volunteers staff making & awareness through community mobilization and outreach in the surrounding areas of slums. We distribute leaflet & poster for heath related information. During the community mobilization we talk to people and we motivate them to be open and frank to share their personal & social issues and receive the solution. Peoples are making friendly respond to this programs. In some special case we are committed to provide them specific support and solution of their any problems.







TSNM, India is committed & focused for adolescence or young generations, or youths; we always encourage & motivate young people and provide them social & healthy platform where they can bring their social and personal issues which has to be discussed. We serve the young boys & girls, especially who are trapped in and alcoholic drugs addictions; we invite them for personal & social counseling; we make them to understand their problem and challenges of their personal life. Then softly our counselor drag them to come out of their major issues and help them to overcome on it.



Our "Youth clubs are called "Chosen Generation Youth Club" in this club there are 50 - 60 young boys and girls who are drawn out from their bad habits. Every 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Saturday we conduct youth meetings; in this youth meeting our youth counselor makes counseling on generally assigned subject.

In this youth club we also provide free carrier counseling, educational counseling, and personal counseling, our goal and motive of this youth club is to equip the young boys and girls with their hard core potentials and prepare them for the betterment of the our societies as well as our country. Under this unite we also help young boys and girls to get proper vocational training & job to earn some resources for their families.

Women Empowerment Programs

Adult Literacy Program:-

TSNM, India is focused to educate our women's of our Adult society. literacy programs aims "Saab Parhe aur Saab Barhe" under this programs we are helping poor & marginalized migrant worker specially women, who have lost the opportunity and have crossed the age of formal education, but now feel a need for learning of any type, literacy. including basic education. We are helping such people specially who lives in slums to gain literacy skills which helps to Reduce poverty and improve public health.

Our Programs promote adult literacy programs through:

• Basic Literacy (reading & writing, Basic Math)



Women safety & Domestic Violence:-



In year 2022- 23, as like passed year, TSNM-India continue to take a significant initiative to create awareness against domestic violence, child trafficking, and sexual harassment of girl/ women's of the slums. Last year we could conduct various such awareness & counselling camps with the association of "Parivartan Cell" of Delhi Police. Through these programs large numbers of women's and girl could get awareness regarding sexual harassment and domestic violence. Around 500 (five hundreds) women's and girl could get benefitted with this programs.

Women's counseling & fellowship: -



TSNM-India is committed for the women's development programs. Which is partial populace of India. Now also women's are facing struggle to get there equal rights and life with dignity. In year 2022-23, we have made our best to initiate for the development of the women's in our male dominant society. We use to hold the program called **"Muhhalla Mahila Sabha" or "Mahila Panchayat"** and community mobilization programs. These programs are women oriented programs led by women (experts) and intended to reaching and identifying such women who is victim of social and domestic violence and who has needs of social and family counseling.

We encouraged such women to get counseled with the expert. Through this such initiative around 3000 (Three Thousand) women's from suraj park, samaypur, jeevan park get benefitted. And as per result they are happy with their spouse and family and living their lives with respect and dignity in their families.

Vocational Training Programs

TSNM, India is focused and dedicated to livelihood empowerment programs through vocational & skill development programs. Under this programs we are running "Uthhan Cutting & Tailoring Center" which is located Basti Vikash in Kendra (BVK), J.J. Camp, Suraj Park, Samaipur, and Delhi - 42. In our cutting & tailoring center at present we have 8 sewing hand machines which is being used by the students. It has daily three classes of $1^{1/2}$ hours; we have 15 - 20 students for six month in each batch.





We run this vocational training for women/widows and drop-outs girls, who are poor, marginalized, and slum dwellers. Our motto is the help them to start their family earnings with this cuttings and tailorings programs. We provide this course absolutely free of cost. All the students are selected through the communities survey, our staff or volunteers visit their houses and after approving their condition we select them for vocational training. Since last passing years 2022-23 we have trained more than 300 students for cuttings and tailorings. Now they all are dependent and earning for their families & relatives.



<u>Health Camp/Medical Camp</u>: -



In year 2022-23, The Salvation of Nations Ministry (TSNM-India), organized several free health check-up camps, eye camp and Health awareness & counselling programs in different location of Delhi.

All camps were conduct with association of Dr. Shroff Eye Charitable Hospital & Dr. Rajendra Prasad Eye Hospital & Samaj Sewa Trust. Last passing years we made 169 referral 154 recommended cataract patients and help them to get treated. Around 700-750 specs were freely distributed to old age people and children's and more than 2000 (Two Thousand) people in different areas get benefitted with these programs.

Cultural & National programs: -

"The Salvation of Nations Ministry" is committed to serve the country & countrymen; we always feel pride to be Indian and we owe to our country. Every year we celebrate all national celebration in honor of our country.

We celebrate Independence Day, Republic Day, Gandhi Jayanti, and Children's Day etc. We encourage people of our local community to get involved and participate in such cultural and national programs. Last year also we had opportunity to celebrate 76th Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti, and Children's Day & Republic Day.

We invite local young people in such programs; so that they may get engaged in social & cultural activities. During the programs we use to host our national flag with national anthem and the local respected senior citizen and our staff, volunteer and local attendees presented song and dance, our education center students made a speech on Independence Day and & Republic Days. We encourage children's and young people to be honest and sincere for our country, we use to make appeal to the gathering to come forward to make changes in our society against corruption, violence, and many other social challenges. In such programs many people are getting inspired and helping the people and society.

Self-Help Group Training Program (SHTP): -

As you all know TSNM-India is actively engaged in poverty reduction programs. Since 2020 we took one more initiatives toward poverty eradication from the poor and marginalized community of India like slums & villages. And initiative taken in the form of "Self-help training programs -SHTP. Since last two years couple of SHTP program has been held, in the slums & unauthorized colonies of Delhi. In the programs we train people to earn their basic monthly income; during the program we teach & train the women's to make pickle, detergent & surf, and phenyl etc. This program was helpful for the women's of the slums around 300 (three hundreds women's get benefitted from SHTP programs in various part of Delhi. I have seen women's who participated in the programs could make their earnings for their families.

COVID-19 Relief Program: -





The Salvation of Nations Ministry (TSNM-India) had privilege to distribute dry ration to migrant laborer or daily wages people especially to the poor & needy women's. The Ration kit (wheat, rice pulse, salt, spices, soyabean, chana, sugar, tea, soap, surf etc.) We use to provide ration for one month etc. In throughout the years we have been distributing ration to the poorest of poor people according to their need. TSNM-India distributed ration to men's & women's of the slums. Throughout the year we could also distributed grocery & ration one to one around 50 family gets benefitted. 100 (Hundreds) of surgical mask to into the slums, and still the same is going on in individual manners.

Clean & drinking water Project: -



The Salvation of Nations Ministry (TSNM-India) had privilege to serve people in Unnao, Uttar Pradesh. In year 2022-23 we could reach the village of Unnao in Uttar Pradesh. There major observation was made of safe & clean drinking water was not available for the village people. Our team made out reach & survey the villages (such like Nandulan khera, Fakira khera, Maurwan etc.). Finally decisions was made to provide them safe & clean water by by providing them hand pump; each hand pump for 10-12 family holds. In year 2022-23 we provide hand pump in two villages.

Numerical Details of beneficiaries for Years 2022-23

- Around 12,000 children's get benefited through our various children's programs.
- ✤ More than 10000 women's get benefited from our programs of women's.
- ✤ 250 people were treated by cataract operations.
- ✤ 10000 people were aware of cleanliness & illness of the societies.
- ✤ 500 face mask & surgical mask were distributed in the slums of Suraj Park, sanjay Gandhi transport, Bhagwan pur, and sanjay Colony.
- ♦ 1000 women's are getting benefited with adult literacy programs. Still going on
- 50 poorest of poor migrant family get benefitted with dry ration distribution. (These are the approximate number, but impact of work is beyond these numbers*.)
- In year 2021-22 we could provide hand pump in villages under safe drinking water project in Uttar Pradesh.
- ✤ 500 poorest of poor migrant children's & women's were distributes old clothes & shoes distribution.
